The Parish Council has received numerous complaints about dog fouling, particularly in the Kings Street, Shopeth Road and Queensway areas with a minority of irresponsible dog owners not cleaning up after their dogs on pavements, grass verges and even more worryingly, grassed play area.

Dog fouling is a public health issue and can cause serious illness particularly amongst children if they come into contact with dog mess. Woodmansey Parish Council is working with East Riding Council's Dog Warden to address this unacceptable behaviour and the Dog Warden will be increasing patrols in the above areas.

The Parish Council would strongly urge all dog owners to clean up any mess their dog(s) make and to think of other people who live in the area and would remind dog owners that they could be fined £1000 for not cleaning up after their dogs. The Parish Council will fully support the prosecution of anyone found guilty of this offence.
