Dear Judith,
many thanks for your reply.

We would be very grateful if you could ask Woodmansey Parish Council to consider our application for some support, if at all possible. As stated previously, Beverley Community Lift offers a caring community transport service, using volunteer drivers, for elderly and disabled people who cannot easily use other forms of transport.

Our service is currently being used by a small number of Woodmansey Parish residents, and we would like this number to increase so that more residents are able to access this valuable transport provision.

We already provide a door-to-door minibus service once a week to collect residents from the sheltered housing on Shopeth Way to take them to Morrisons for shopping, and our car service is used to take Woodmansey parishioners to medical appointments, such as to their GP, hospital appointments, opticians etc.

The support we are requesting will help us to expand the service that we offer to Woodmansey parishioners. To do this, we need to raise awareness of our service to attract new passengers, and recruit more volunteer drivers.

For this aim, we would like to request the following:

1. £134.40 to print 5,000 A5 sized, double-sided leaflets, which will be hand delivered (by working in partnership with the ERYC community payback scheme) to each household in Woodmansey. These leaflets will promote the car service specifically to new passengers and also hope to attract new volunteer drivers. Please find attached a copy of our general leaflet as an idea of what this new leaflet could look like, but please bear in mind that the new leaflet would very much be specific to Woodmansey.

2. The support of Councillors in helping us to raise awareness of our charity and its services to Woodmansey residents whenever the opportunity arises.

The Beverley Community Lift car service offers people so much more than just a lift to their appointments. It is needs-based, and helps people to retain their independence for as long as possible. It also improves mental and physical well being by reducing social isolation and feelings of loneliness.

I trust that this provides the information required by Councillors, but if I can help further, please do let me know.

Your assistance is very much appreciated.
