I would like to post my concerns regarding the speeding along Hull Road Dunswell/Woodmansey.

Barring the 40mph the rest of the road is 30mph which in my opinion is the correct speed limit for this road. However it is a daily occurrence that motorists speed and not just slightly.

I live on the bend next to the church in Woodmansey and cars 'fly' around the corner here and one day one will end up in our house.

The main issues is the long straight stretch past Beverley Garden Centre where cars overtake others speeding by 50/60+mph and then do not slow down.

There are mobile speed cameras every now and again but this does not do anything, motorists just slow down before getting to them.

Something needs to be done as it is getting increasingly worse. I feel that average speed cameras are required along this road as this will be the only way that people will slow down.
